YEAR 12 SUNRAYZIA SCHOOL BALL

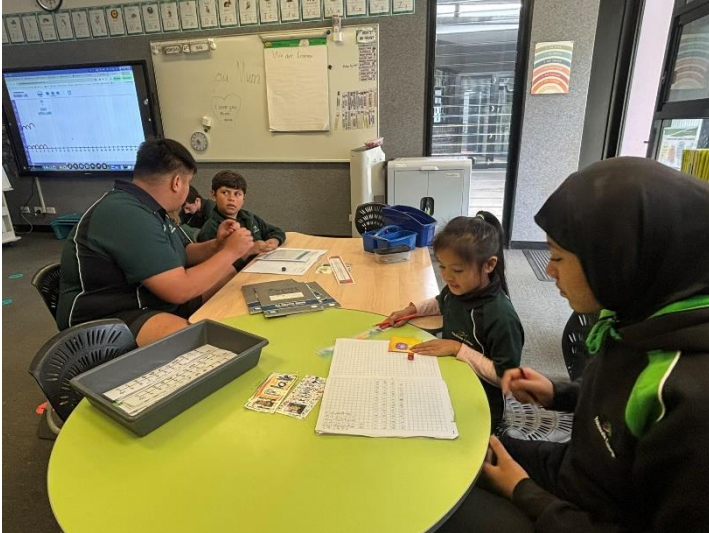

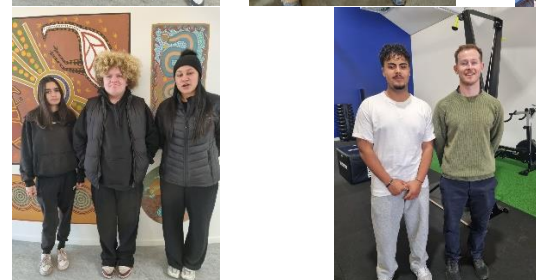


YEAR 10 WORK EXPERIENCE

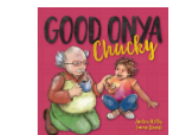
